PLANNING COMMISSION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 27, 2010:

Dillon Residence – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC10-00007) for the construction of a 248-square-foot deck expansion attached to an existing deck at the western building elevation located at 1011 South Pacific Street. ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Martinek – Absent) and adopted the resolution; the call for review/appeal period ends on October 7, 2010.***

MacDonald Residence – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC-2-06) to allow an existing open second-story balcony to be enclosed and to permit the replacement of the existing wood siding to be replaced with a stucco wall finish at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. ***The Commission voted 6-0 (Martinek – Absent) to continue this item to the October 25, 2010 public hearing.***
