## Civic Center Library renovation closure

The dates of the Civic Center Library renovation have changed slightly due to the necessary lead time for carpet and materials delivery. The Library will close on Monday November 22, and a small annex will open in one-half of the Community Rooms on November 29 to provide basic book checkout and return services. The Mission Branch library will have extended hours during the closure period and the Bookmobile will add two stops near the Country Club Senior Center and Joe Balderrama Park. Civic Center Library reopening is currently scheduled for February 14, 2011.

# **Library hosts Job Fair**

A job fair will be held on Wednesday October 20 from 10 am to 2 pm in the Civic Center Library Community Rooms. The event is cosponsored by the Library, North County Career Centers and the Employment Development Department. More than 20 employers are registered for the fair. The event is free and open to the public. Library resources and job search databases will be highlighted at the fair.

### Fair at Balderrama Park

The Eastside Fall Resource Fair will be held this Saturday, October 16th, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at Joe Balderrama Park. This is an event co-sponsored by Eastside UCAN and will feature resource booths, and games for the kids along with Save Our Streets activities.

## Casa de Amparo expands service population

Recently, San Diego County Child Welfare Services (CWS) needs and delivery methods revealed two underserved populations of children affected by abuse or neglect in the community. Responding to these evolving, critical needs of foster children/youth, Casa de Amparo's Children's Shelter is expanding its target population to include residential services for children with special health care needs and teen boys experiencing significant emotional and behavioral distress. A child with special health care needs is one who, because of an accident, illness, congenital disorder, abuse or neglect, is dependent on life sustaining medications, treatments, and equipment, and needs assistance with activities of daily living. ### **FEIR Available for Melrose Drive**

The Final Environmental Impact Report for Melrose Drive Extension Project is available for public review at the Development Services Department counter, the Civic Center Main Library, the Mission Branch Library, and the City's Web site under "What's New". Also, a public meeting is scheduled for the Transportation Commission on November

16, 2010, at 7:00 pm, to consider recommendation to certify the FEIR and recommend the preferred alternative to the Council. Residences within the Guajome Neighborhood and those who commented on the draft EIR will receive a mailed notification of the public meeting.

### **Quarry Creek Master Plan**

We have received a copy of the Quarry Creek Master Plan from the City of Carlsbad for review by November 5, 2010. The project is located on the 100-acre former Hanson Aggregate Quarry located at the western terminus of Marron Road and Haymar Street and west of the Quarry Creek Shopping Center. The project proposes over 600 housing units, which will be utilizing City of Oceanside streets for egress and ingress (Marron, Haymar, College Boulevard, etc.) and potentially many City of Oceanside services (water, sewer, Police, Fire, etc.).
