Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, October 25, 2010:

MacDonald Residence – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC-2-06) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed and to permit the replacement of the existing wood siding to be replaced with a stucco wall finish at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. (Item continued from the September 27, 2010 public hearing). ***Staff is recommending approval.***

The Oceansider – Consideration of a revocation of Development Plan (D-19-03) and Conditional Use Permit (C-29-03) and associated resolutions (2004-P22 and 2007-P46) for failure to comply with Conditions of Approval in the established time frames. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

Stensrud Addition – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC10-00004) to allow an addition to an existing single-family residence, through the partial enclosure of an existing open deck area. The subject property is located at 1705 South Pacific Street. ***Staff is recommending approval.***
