Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, October 25, 2010:

<u>MacDonald Residence</u> – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC-2-06) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed and to permit the replacement of the existing wood siding to be replaced with a stucco wall finish at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *The Commission voted 3-3 on the project, no action was taken (Martinek, Bertheaud, Scrivener – No) (Troisi – Absent)*

<u>The Oceansider</u> – Consideration of a revocation of DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D-19-03) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (C-29-03) and associated resolutions (2004-P22 and 2007-P46) for failure to comply with Conditions of Approval in the established time frames. *This project has been continued to the November 8, 2010 public hearing*.

<u>Stensrud Addition</u> – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC10-00004) to allow an addition to an existing single-family residence, through the partial enclosure of an existing open deck area. *The Commission voted 3-3 on the project, no action was taken (Martinek, Rosales, Scrivener – No) (Troisi – Absent)*

Mission Avenue Affordable Housing Mixed-use Project

In July, per Council authorization, the City released a Request for Qualifications to develop the Mission Avenue Affordable Housing Mixed-use project. Six submittals were received by the deadline in August. After an initial review and rating by staff (Deputy City Manager Michelle Lawrence, Development Services Director George Buell, Principal Planner Amy Fousekis, Dave Manley and myself, staff forwarded three submittals for the Housing Commission to consider. The three development teams for consideration were Bridge Housing/North County Solutions for Change, National CORE/Community HousingWorks, and Wasatch Advantage. The Housing Commission unanimously is recommending that National CORE/Community HousingWorks be the development team for the site. Staff will be recommending that the City enter into an Exclusive Negotiating Agreement with National CORE/Community HousingWorks. In addition, the Housing Commission and staff are recommending that the project be named Mission Cove.
