## **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

# **Planning Commission**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, November 8, 2010.

<u>The Oceansider</u> – Consideration of a revocation of Development Plan (D-19-03) and Conditional Use Permit (C-29-03) and associated resolutions (2004-P22 and 2007-P46) for failure to comply with Conditions of Approval in the established time frames. This item has been continued from the October 25, 2010, public hearing. **Staff is recommending approval.** 

<u>MacDonald Residence</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC-2-06) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed and to permit the replacement of the existing wood siding to be replaced with a stucco wall finish at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *Staff is recommending approval.* 

Per Municipal Code Section 2.1.34, this item was automatically scheduled for this hearing following a 3-3 vote (constituting No Action) at the preceding public hearing on October 25, 2010.

At the request of the applicant, this item has been continued to the November 15, 2010 public hearing.

<u>Stensrud Addition</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC10-00004) to allow an addition to an existing single-family residence, through the partial enclosure of an existing open deck area. The subject property is located at 1705 South Pacific Street. *Staff is recommending approval.* 

Per Municipal Code Section 2.1.34, this item was automatically scheduled for this hearing following a 3-3 vote (constituting No Action) at the preceding public hearing on October 25, 2010.

### <u>Transportation Commission</u>

<u>Melrose Drive Extension Project</u> – Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) will be presented to the Transportation Commission on November 16, 2010, at 7:00 pm in the Council Chamber. Staff will ask the Transportation Commission to make the recommendation to the City Council to certify the FEIR and select the preferred Alternative A (middle alignment).
