COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting Monday, November 8, 2010.

<u>The Oceansider</u> – Consideration of a revocation of Development Plan (D-19-03) and Conditional Use Permit (C-29-03) and associated resolutions (2004-P22 and 2007-P46) for failure to comply with Conditions of Approval in the established time frames. *The Commission approved the revocation by a 5-1 vote (Bertheaud – No, Balma – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on November 18, 2010.*

<u>MacDonald Residence</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC-2-06) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed and to permit the replacement of the existing wood siding to be replaced with a stucco wall finish at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *This item has been continued to the November 15, 2010 public hearing.*

<u>Stensrud Addition</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC10-00004) to allow an addition to an existing single-family residence, through the partial enclosure of an existing open-deck area. The subject property is located at 1705 South Pacific Street. *This item has been continued to the January 10, 2011 public hearing.*

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, November 15, 2010.

<u>San Luis Rey Crossing</u> – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P10-00004) for a two-lot subdivision of an approximately 1.93-acre site, located at the western terminus of College Boulevard and North River Road. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Red Lobster Restaurant</u> – Consideration of a Development Plan (D10-00003), and Conditional Use Permit (CUP10-00011), for the construction and operation of a new Red Lobster restaurant with full alcoholic beverage service, within an existing commercial center at 2471 Vista Way. *Staff is recommending approval.*

Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) will be presented to the Transportation Commission on November 16, 2010 at 7:00 at the Council Chamber. Staff will ask the Transportation Commission to make the recommendation to the City Council to certify the FEIR and select the preferred Alternative A (middle alignment).
