COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

November 18, 2010

Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, November 15, 2010.

<u>MacDonald Residence</u> – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC-2-06) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed and to permit the replacement of the existing wood siding to be replaced with a stucco wall finish at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *This item has been continued to the December 13, 2010 public hearing.*

<u>San Luis Rey Crossing</u> – Consideration of a TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP (P10-00004) for a two-lot subdivision of an approximately 1.93-acre site, located at the western terminus of College Boulevard and North River Road. *The Commission approved the project by a 4-1 vote (Martinek – No; Rosales, Balma – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on November 29, 2010.*

Red Lobster Restaurant – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D10-00003) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP10-00011) for the construction and operation of a new Red Lobster restaurant with full alcoholic beverage service, within an existing commercial center at 2471 Vista Way. The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Rosales, Balma – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on November 29, 2010.

Melrose Drive Extension Project.

The Transportation Commission, on November 16, approved the recommendation to the Council to certify the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) for the Melrose Drive Extension project and to select the preferred Alternative A (center alignment). The FEIR will be presented to the Planning Commission for their recommendation on December 13, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber.
