Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, December 13, 2010.

MACDONALD RESIDENCE – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC-2-06) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed and to permit the replacement of the existing wood siding to be replaced with a stucco wall finish at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Rosales, Martinek – Absent) (Denied enclosing the 82-foot second floor open balcony by a 4-1 vote, Bertheaud – No) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on December 27, 2010.*

THE GREENS @ ARROWOOD – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D10-00006) a request to establish 5 single-family residential floor plans, each with 3 design options, and 4 distinct color palettes to be constructed within the previously approved Morrow Hills Village "L" single-family residential planned community and modify the finish grades of all 79 pads less than two feet as part of the sites precise grading. The project site is within the North Valley Neighborhood Planning Area. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Rosales, Martinek – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on December 27, 2010.*

Senior Transportation Volunteer Driver program:

The City will be purchasing a web-based ride scheduling system with remaining funds on the New Freedom grant, other transportation services will continue as funded by the TransNet Senior Mini Grant. The system will enable volunteers to select passenger rides with much more ease and convenience to the volunteer. Staff anticipate that this will result in an increase of number of rides provided by each volunteer. The system will also enable staff to better report transportation utilization statistics through the import of shuttle service and taxi scrip data. The system will initially be used internally until staff are fluent with its capabilities and then will open for volunteer use in early 2011. A demonstration will be provided to the Senior Commission at the next regularly scheduled quarterly update.
