

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

January 8, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, January 12, 2009:

Mission San Luis Rey Cemetery Expansion – For the construction of four 4,950 square foot mausoleums, one 800 square foot family mausoleum, new perimeter walls, a 590 square foot committal chapel, a 1,500 square foot temporary office, a 3,323 square foot administrative office, and 24,579 new niche and crypts areas located north of Mission Avenue, between Douglas Drive and Academy Road. This item has been continued to the January 26, 2009 Planning Commission meeting.

500 Motors Revision – To allow vehicle sales and storage within an existing building located at 116 South Coast Highway. This item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-scheduled and re-noticed for a future public hearing.

Upcoming Council public hearing item

The Amazon Bikes Remodel project to construct a 1,800 square foot addition to an existing commercial building located at 1227 Vista Way was call for review. The Council hearing date is anticipated on January 21, 2008.

FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY COORDINATOR FUNDING AWARD

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has notified the City of an award of \$132,000 to pay the salaries of two Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Coordinators in the Neighborhood Services Department for Calendar Year 2009. The FSS Program has been available to households participating in the City's Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program since 1993. Families in the program execute a contract that specifies goals and services; the contract requires that all members become independent of welfare and maintain suitable employment. The FSS Coordinators ensure that the program participants are linked to the supportive services they need to achieve self-sufficiency.

El Corazon Senior Center Bond Funding

The State of California Pooled Money Investment Board voted on December 17, 2008, to freeze all bond-related payments. This freeze includes \$735,000 of bond block grant funds which were approved to the City of Oceanside for the construction of El Corazon Senior Center. The City has appropriated funds to the construction of the El Corazon Senior Center with the intention of reimbursement of \$735,000 by the State. Staff does not foresee this situation to impact the project negatively and intends to continue the project through completion and submit a reimbursement request at that time. The City's reimbursement request will be held by the State Controller until reimbursements resume. The \$735,000 will remain as an account payable to the City by the State until reimbursement is made. The State Board will be convening another meeting in early January to further address the issue.

Tall Ships In Town

Tall Ships will be in Oceanside Harbor on January 10 and 11. Tours will be available.

Bicycle Traffic Skills 101

The San Diego County Bicycle Coalition will be offering this class on January 9 and 10, in the Community Rooms. The class is for adults (bicycle and helmet required for Saturday) and the cost is \$65.
