### **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

#### January 15, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, January 12, 2009:

<u>Mission San Luis Rey Cemetery Expansion</u> – For the construction of four 4,950-squarefoot mausoleums, one 800-square-foot family mausoleum, new perimeter walls, a 590square-foot committal chapel, a 1,500-square-foot temporary office, a 3,323 squarefoot administrative office, and 24,579 new niche and crypts areas located north of Mission Avenue, between Douglas Drive and Academy Road. This item has been continued to the January 26, 2009, Planning Commission meeting.

<u>500 Motors Revision</u> – To allow vehicle sales and storage within an existing building located at 116 South Coast Highway. This item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-scheduled and re-noticed for a future public hearing.

#### Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebrations

The annual commemoration events for Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. will be held this weekend. The first event will be a birthday celebration on Saturday at 4:00 p.m. at the MiraCosta College Theatre. This event will include announcement of the 2009 City of Oceanside – Martin Luther King, Jr. Civic Award recipient; the event is free and open to the public. A Community Prayer Breakfast will be held on Monday, January 19, at 7:30 a.m. at the MiraCosta College Student Center; the cost is \$25.00, \$10.00 for youth. Both events are sponsored by the North San Diego County Branch of the NAACP.

#### U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) – Los Angeles Field Office issued the annual review letter for Program Year 2007-08, covering activities and achievements utilizing Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnership and Emergency Shelter Grants Program funds. The review letter is based on the annual Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER), which the City filed with HUD in September 2008. Based on this review, HUD has determined that the City's overall performance is good; HUD uses only three categories for their review: good, needs improvement, and poor. Copies of the review letter are available from the Neighborhood Services Department; the CAPER is posted on the City's Web site on the Housing Web page.

#### WEEKEND MENTORING FOR AT/IN-RISK YOUTH

The Save Our Streets faith-based group is partnering with Joe Palmer from Bullseye Theory Coaching & Training, Oceanside Unified School District, The Samoan Cultural Committee and the Oceanside Community Safety Partnership for a mentoring program at Oceanside High School (OHS) this weekend, January 17 and 18. OHS students determined to be at/in risk are being selected by school counselors to attend this voluntary two-day program. Volunteer mentors will participate with youth in the program which will be facilitated by Joe Palmer. There will be a four week follow-up period focusing on goals the students will set over the weekend, as well as group community service opportunities for participating students.

#### Marshall Street Pool

Due to the high demand for pool use, the City will open Marshall Street Pool on Monday, February 16, 2009, for Oceanside Unified School District and the Oceanside Swim Club. Both groups have been approached regarding assistance with the funding of this extended season.

#### Brooks Street Swim Center

The pool will be closed for one week beginning February 15 - 22. The pool will be retrofitted for newly required drain covers. This will put the City in compliance with the new Baker Law. The 2009 Lifeguard Academy starts Saturday, January 17.
