COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

February 5, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, February 9, 2009:

<u>Ceja's Mexican Grill</u> – To sell beer and wine in a Mexican restaurant establishment located at 4259 Oceanside Boulevard, Suite 105. Staff is recommending approval.

North County Place – For the construction of a 5,110-square-foot commercial building and construction of two retaining walls with a maximum height of 20.5 feet and 22 feet on a 0.5-acre portion of a 3.69-acre site located within the 2200 block of South El Camino Real. Staff is recommending approval.

North Coast United Methodist Church Parcel Map – To subdivide an 8.884-acre parcel into two lots measuring 4.784 and 4.05-acres located at 1501 Kelly Street. This item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-scheduled and re-noticed for a future public hearing.

<u>DEI, LLC @ Vista Way</u> – To subdivide an existing 1.867-acre commercial lot into two parcels to construct a 23,260-square-foot three-story commercial office building on the newly created 0.701-acre lot located northeast of the intersection of Vista Way and Valley Glen Drive. Staff is recommending approval.

<u>Kruger Residence</u> – To permit a 54-foot tall ground mounted HAM radio antenna that exceeds the maximum allowable height requirement located at 142 Carey Road. Staff is recommending denial.

Skateparks

The Skatepark at Melba Bishop Park opened to the public last Friday, January 30, 2009. The park provides an additional 8,000-square-feet of concrete park for skaters of all ages to enjoy. The 6,000-square-feet Martin Luther King, Jr. Park opening was highlighted in the January 2009 edition of the Transworld Business Magazine. Both parks are the first Grindline parks built in Southern California.
