

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

February 12, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, February 9, 2009:

Ceja's Mexican Grill – To sell beer and wine in a Mexican restaurant establishment located at 4259 Oceanside Boulevard, Suite 105. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on February 19, 2009.

North County Place – For the construction of a 5,110-square-foot commercial building and construction of two retaining walls with a maximum height of 20.5 feet and 22 feet on a 0.5-acre portion of a 3.69-acre site located within the 2200 block of South El Camino Real. The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on February 19, 2009.

North Coast United Methodist Church Parcel Map – To subdivide an 8.884-acre parcel into two lots measuring 4.784 and 4.05-acres located at 1501 Kelly Street. This item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-scheduled and re-noticed for a future public hearing.

DEI, LLC @ Vista Way – To subdivide an existing 1.867-acre commercial lot into two parcels to construct a 23,260-square-foot three-story commercial office building on the newly created 0.701-acre lot located northeast of the intersection of Vista Way and Valley Glen Drive. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on February 19, 2009.

Kruger Residence – To permit a 54-foot tall ground mounted HAM radio antenna that exceeds the maximum allowable height requirement located at 142 Carey Road. The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote. The resolution will be considered at the next Planning Commission meeting on February 23, 2009.
