

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

April 16, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, April 20, 2009:

Wings, Pizza n' Things Restaurant – To expand alcohol services to beer, wine and spirits in an existing eating and drinking establishment located at 4225 Oceanside Boulevard, Suite Z, within the Developers Resources Plaza Mottino Shopping Center, otherwise known as Rancho Del Oro Gateway. ***Staff is recommending denial.***

El Corazon Specific Plan – For the El Corazon Specific Plan, including the Rancho Del Oro Specific Plan and Ocean Ranch Master Development Plan to remove the project from these planning areas. The Specific Plan will be located on a 465-acre site at the northeast corner of Oceanside Boulevard and El Camino Real. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

Bob's Gas Station – To permit moving truck rentals at an existing gas station located at 1742 South Coast Highway. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

American Tower @ Prince of Peace Abbey – For an existing, stand-alone wireless telecommunications facility located at 675 Benet Hill Road. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

Title I allocations to local school district

The U.S. Department of Education has released preliminary estimates of Title I allocations to local education agencies under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. Title I, the largest elementary and secondary education program, supplements State and local funding for low-achieving children, especially in high-poverty schools. The program finances the additional academic support and learning opportunities that are often required to help disadvantaged students progress along with their classmates. These allocations are in addition to the funds that will be allocated under the annual FY 2009 appropriation. Preliminary estimates show that Oceanside Unified will receive \$3.2 million and Vista Unified \$3.5 million.

NCTD Service to El Corazon Senior Center

North County Transit District has been working with the City to include a stop at the El Corazon Senior Center. The service is planned for Route 317 to include a stop prior to and after a stop at the RDO Sprinter Station, **Monday through Friday, 7am to 7pm**. The City's Property Management Division and City Attorney's office is currently reviewing a Hold Harmless Agreement for NCTD to enter City property. The service is planned to stop at the front curb of the senior center.
