COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

May 7, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, May 4, 2009:

Exxon Gas Station #44 – For the construction of a 815- square-foot drive-thru carwash, and to convert an existing 1,827-square-foot service bay into a food mart and retail use for an existing gas station located at 3401 College Boulevard. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on May 14, 2009.

<u>Pacific Marine Credit Union</u> – To permit the development of a 56,700-square-foot office building with 4,000 square feet of the building to be devoted to banking located on the southwest corner of Old Grove Road and College Boulevard. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on May 14, 2009.

<u>Schreiber Residence</u> – To allow a previously approved project three additional years to construct a single-family residence on a 2,500-square-foot lot with reduced exterior corner sideyard setbacks located at 526 South Cleveland Street. The Commission approved the project by a 5-2 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on May 14, 2009.

<u>Sprint/Nextel @ Surfride</u> – To operate three existing antennas concealed within a structure located at 1909 South Coast Highway. The Commission approved the project by a 5-2 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on May 14, 2009.

Neighborhood Stabilization Fund

The California Housing and Community Development Department released a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) on April 30. The NSP provides funding to local jurisdictions to assist in the redevelopment of abandoned or foreclosed homes and other residential properties. Congress appropriated funds for this grant program but the City did not qualify for a direct allocation from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The City is eligible for \$1,422,487 of NSP funds from the State; the application for these funds is due June 15, and requires two public hearings fifteen days apart. The first hearing will be held before the Housing Commission at a special meeting on Monday, May 18, at 6:15 p.m.; the second hearing will be held at the June 10 City Council meeting. Airport Agreements with Airport Property Ventures (APV)

Following an April 14 conference call with the FAA, City staff and APV summarized the FAA's comments and proposed language changes to the lease and operating agreements to address the FAA's concerns. The summary and proposed changes were shared with APV's consultant (David Bennett, a former FAA employee), who then met in person with FAA officials in Washington, D.C. On May 4, 2009, City staff participated in another conference call with APV representatives and Mr. Bennett to review the results of his meeting with the FAA. Mr. Bennett is working on further refining the proposed changes to the agreements and expects to circulate those suggestions by early next week. APV representatives, City staff and Mr. Bennett plans to meet again with FAA officials in Washington, D.C. to review the specific proposed changes to the lease and operating agreements in order to confirm that the changes will satisfy the FAA's concerns.
