COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

May 21, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, May 18, 2009:

<u>Vine Street Commercial</u> – To construct a 13,574-square-foot grocery market with an attached 3,000-square-foot retail suite on a 1.878-acre parcel located at the northwest corner of Vine Street and Oceanside Boulevard. This item has been continued to the June 8, 2009 Planning Commission meeting.

<u>Calls For Review Process Amendment</u> – Amending Article 46 of the Zoning Ordinance to require filing of a call for review request by at least two City Council members in lieu of one City Council member in order to initiate such a review, and establishing the amended text as part of the implementing document of the Local Coastal Program. The Commission recommended approval of the amendment and adopt the resolution by a 7-0 vote. The City Council public hearing is set for June 10, 2009.

<u>Mini-Dorms</u> – Amending sections of the Zoning Ordinance regulating high density residential occupancies more commonly referred to as "mini-dorms" within single-family neighborhoods Citywide. The Commission recommended approval of the amendment and adopt the resolution by a 6-1 vote. The City Council public hearing is anticipated for July 1, 2009.

Oceanview Plaza – To create three residential lots; to create 15 commercial condominiums; to allow off-street parking on lands designated as residential; and to allow façade enhancements to an existing commercial building located at 2420 Vista Way. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on May 28, 2009.

<u>7-Eleven @ Douglas Drive and Mission Avenue</u> – To allow for the 24-hour operation of a convenience store located at 3899 Douglas Drive. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on May 28, 2009.

Coast Highway Vision

As many of you know, the Coast Highway Vision and Strategic Plan was adopted by the City Council on April 15. City staff is currently working on follow-up implementation actions per City Council direction.
