COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

June 4, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, June 8, 2009:

<u>Vine Street Commercial</u> – To construct a 13,574-square-foot grocery market with an attached 3,000-square-foot retail suite on a 1.878-acre parcel located at the northwest corner of Vine Street and Oceanside Boulevard. Staff is recommending approval.

<u>South Pacific Street Remodel</u> – To allow for the addition of 1,144 square feet of living space and a 260-square-foot deck to an existing single-family residence located at 1733 South Pacific Street. Staff is recommending approval.

California Manufacturing Technology Consulting

Oceanside businesses will soon be given a valuable opportunity to participate in a program called California Manufacturing Technology Consulting (CMTC). This program assists manufacturers, assemblers, and distributors that have annual sales less than \$15 million, with subject specific issues or needs that they need addressed. The free program offers one on one consulting as well as a written report with recommendations on achieving specific business goals. The Economic and Community Development Department will notify nearly 200 businesses by mail on June 1; letters will be sent along with a CMTC brochure describing the services available to them.

Neighborhood Revitalization Program

The City is eligible to apply for \$1,422,487 from the State of California through the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP). The NSP provides funds to acquire and rehabilitate abandoned or foreclosed residential properties to reduce neighborhood blight. The City proposes to work with nonprofit organizations to acquire and rehabilitate vacant residential properties that can then be used as "next step" rental properties for families moving out of transitional housing. The proposal will be brought to the City Council on Wednesday, June 15. The program would be limited to Oceanside residents.

El Corazon Senior Center - Grand Opening Event

This event will be held on Saturday, June 6, at the new El Corazon Senior Center. The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will take place at 4:00 pm. An open house with music and light refreshments will follow. The theme: "Our Seniors are the Stars". Dress: Business attire/cocktail dress.

On Monday, June 15, and Tuesday, June 16, the Parks and Recreation Dance Classes will hold their annual recital at the Truax Theater at El Camino High School. Over 250
