

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

June 25, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, June 22, 2009:

North Coast United Methodist Church – To subdivide an 8.884-acre parcel into two lots measuring 4.784 and 4.05 acres located at 1501 Kelly Street. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on July 2, 2009.

Ivey Ranch Park Equestrian Center – For the expansion and development of a new equestrian center consisting of a 10,176-square-foot stable, pipe corrals, two modular classrooms, riding areas, and a 211.1-square-foot restroom located on the southeast corner of Rancho Del Oro Drive and Mission Avenue. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on July 2, 2009.

Senior Shuttle Closed for FY 08-09:

The Senior Shuttle Program is now full for FY 08-09. The transportation provider, American Logistics, is referring customers to the Senior Center where they can seek a taxi scrip or a volunteer driver ride. The Senior Transportation Program will be on the July 1 City Council agenda for acceptance of TransNet funds and approval of an amendment to the American Logistics contract extending shuttle services through June 30, 2010.
