COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

July 30, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, July 27, 2009:

The Villa at Mission San Luis Rey – For the construction of a four-story, 348,896-square foot, 235-unit continuing care retirement center on an 8.01-acre site within plan area 9 of the Mission San Luis Rey Planned Development Plan. The project site is located on the southwest corner of the Mission property at 4050 Mission Avenue, bounded by the Mission Lavanderia to the east, Mission Avenue to the south and the Seniors' Community of Mission Manor to the west. *This item has been continued to the August 10, 2009 Planning Commission meeting.*

Jones Residence – For the construction of a single-family residence located at 74 Saint Malo Beach. *This item has been continued to the September 14, 2009 Planning Commission meeting.*

Tait Street Condominiums – To permit the demolition of an existing residential structure to enable the construction of a 7,542-square foot two-unit condominium with a four-car tandem garage located at 916 Tait Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on August 6, 2009.*

Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment – Amending Articles 41 and 43 of the Zoning Ordinance for automatic time extensions for 2 years of development plans, conditional use permits, variances and coastal permits. *The Commission recommend approval of the amendment by a 6-0 vote and the City Council hearing is set for August 19, 2009.*

Local youth Shadow Day

The City will be hosting approximately 20 local youth in a Job Shadow Day on July 31. The youths will arrive at 9:00 am for a tour of the City facilities (water plant, COC, OPD, Fire Station, City Hall). After the tour and lunch the sponsoring departments will met their shadows and will be shadowed for the remainder of the day.

DASANI BLUE BIKE PROGRAM TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

The City's Blue Bike Program has become very popular and Parks and Recreation has issued close to 1300 "Smart Cards" to individuals and ten cards were issued to the Wyndham for use by their guests. Unfortunately, we have had many problems with the lockers, return of bicycles, and maintenance leading us to the decision that the program be suspended. As of today, there are seven missing bikes. The Police Department is assisting with tracking them down and hopefully we will be able to recover the bikes.

The "Smart Card" system is not user friendly and people have difficulty getting the lockers to work properly and making it impossible for staff to track via the computer

system who checked out which bike and which bikes were returned by whom. In addition, the maintenance of the bicycles is not in the city's budget and in the past six months, \$1800 has been spent on maintenance. There are currently 8 bikes with flat tires and in need of repair. Staff is looking for ways that we could resume this program; however, without funding for improvements, it is unlikely that the program will be viable.
