COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

August 6, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, August 10, 2009:

The Villa at Mission San Luis Rey – For the construction of a four-story, 348,896-square foot, 235-unit continuing care retirement center on an 8.01-acre site within plan area 9 of the Mission San Luis Rey Planned Development Plan. The project site is located on the southwest corner of the Mission property at 4050 Mission Avenue, bounded by the Mission Lavanderia to the east, Mission Avenue to the south and the Seniors' Community of Mission Manor to the west. *Staff is recommending approval.*

Oceanside Boulevard Sidewalk and Landscape Improvements

A open house will be held in the Library Community Rooms from 5PM to 7PM on Monday, August 10, 2009 to allow stakeholders involved in the Oceanside Boulevard visioning process to review sidewalk and landscape improvement plans for the south side of Oceanside Boulevard between Interstate 5 and the Crouch Street Sprinter Station. City staff will provide two plan sets for public review and also be available for questions. Representatives of the LANA (Loma Alta Neighborhood Association), LAMP (Loma Alta Mission Park), OCNA (Oceanside Coastal Neighborhood Association) and Fire Mountain neighborhood groups have been notified of the open house.

Supplement Emergency Food and Shelter Program under the ARRZ of 2009
San Diego County has been awarded \$1,039,932 under this program. The San Diego Emergency Food and Shelter Program Board is accepting competitive applications for supplemental pantry food and congregate food money. Qualifying agencies with pantries can receive items such as rice, pasta, canned foods, oatmeal, soups, etc. Agencies serving consistent meals can apply to be reimbursed for meals served by their food programs. Organizations must have non-profit status for at least one year, have a functioning board, an established accounting system, conduct annual audits, provide non-discriminatory assistance to needy individuals, ability to deliver program, agency must be on 2-1-1 listing, provide case management or referrals and clients cannot be required to volunteer or pay for services. Applications must be postmarked by August 14th.

Award of additional funds from HUD to support the City's Section 8 Voucher Program
The Neighborhood Services Department applied to the U.S. Department of Housing and
Urban Development (HUD) for additional funding to support the City's Section 8
Housing Choice Voucher program and was recently notified of an award of \$498,835 for
rental assistance subsidies for current program participants. This funding is in addition
to the \$12,581,161 previously awarded by HUD for Calendar Year 2009. HUD provided
the additional funding to Housing Authorities that have experienced a significant
increase in subsidies paid to landlords. In Oceanside, subsidies have increased due to
increased participant unemployment and decreases in public benefits, including cash

assistance for families with children and social security benefits for persons with disabilities. The additional funding will ensure that staff can continue to assist all households currently participating in the program.
