Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, August 10, 2009:

The Villa at Mission San Luis Rey – For the construction of a four-story, 348,896-square foot, 235-unit continuing care retirement center, on an 8.01-acre site within plan area 9 of the Mission San Luis Rey Planned Development Plan. The project site is located on the southwest corner of the Mission property at 4050 Mission Avenue, bounded by the Mission Lavanderia to the east, Mission Avenue to the south and the Seniors' Community of Mission Manor to the west. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on August 20, 2009.*
