COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

August 27, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, August 24, 2009:

Dillion Residence – To permit the remodel of an existing duplex and to extend two west facing balconies located at 1301 South Pacific Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on September 3, 2009.*

California Career School – To permit the operation of a temporary trucking school for a maximum five-years for vocational and occupational training located on the northeast corner of Rancho Del Oro Drive and Ocean Ranch Boulevard. *This item has been continued to the September 28, 2009 Planning Commission meeting. A Cease and Desist order will be issued.*

Cingular Wireless/AT & T — For the leasing and operation of an existing communication facility consisting of 12 directional antennas mounted to a 88-foot tall mono-palm located at 4079 Calle Platino. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on September 3, 2009.*

South Pacific Street Property-Lot 17 – To permit the demolition of an existing multi-unit residential complex to enable the construction of a 4,728-square foot single-family residence with a four-car tandem garage located at 831 South Pacific Street. *This item has been removed from the agenda and will be rescheduled and renoticed for a future public hearing.*

South Pacific Street Property-Lot 18 – To permit the demolition of an existing multi-unit residential complex to enable the construction of a 4,739-square foot single-family residence with a four-car tandem garage located at 833 South Pacific Street. *This item has been removed from the agenda and will be rescheduled and renoticed for a future public hearing.*

San Diego Space for Art Project

The weekend of September 11th through 13th, architects, artists, designers, planners, developers, arts supporters and community members, will gather at the New School of Architecture and Design in San Diego to take part in a design charrette to develop innovative and creative designs for permanent, affordable work/live space for San Diego artists and arts organizations (San Diego Space for Art project aka sdspace4art).

Architects will be leading or joining one of the 15 - 20 design teams that will be working on one of the 6 - 10 selected buildings or sites around Downtown, North Park, City

Heights and one site in North San Diego County to develop architectural prototypes that will respond to the needs of local artists and communities.

On August 26, 2009, City staff joined representatives of a newly formed non-profit group (Partners for Innovative Community, Inc.) and design professionals in a walking tour of Oceanside's Arts Technology and Environment District. The purpose of the walking tour is to preliminarily assess the potential of site(s) in the District as the North San Diego County entry. Staff will observe and provide background planning input only to tour participants.

Playground Safety Inspector Class

The Neighborhood Services Department, Parks & Recreation Division co-sponsored the Nations Parks and Recreation Association "National Playground Safety Inspector Class" in the community rooms this week. In exchange for hosting the group, three Public Works/Beach and Harbor employees were able to attend the training and be eligible to be certified Park and Recreation Playground equipment inspectors at no cost (\$1500 savings).
