Coast Highway Community Revitalization Incentive Program

Initiate discussion and work toward formulating a comprehensive Community Revitalization Incentive Program to promote excellence in development and growth efficiency within the Coast Highway planning area, consistent with the Coast Highway Vision and Strategic Plan.

Mission Avenue Affordable Housing Mixed Use Development Site Community Workshop

The 3rd community workshop for the Mission Avenue Affordable Housing Mixed Use Development Visioning process will be held on Monday, September 14, 2009, from 6:00-7:30 pm. The meeting will be held at the Marty's Best Western Inn Conference Center located at 3240 Mission Avenue, which is located directly across Mission Avenue from the project site. The City's consultant, RRM Design Group, will be presenting the conceptual plan which incorporates comments and suggestions received from the public at the first two workshops that were held in April and July of this year. Informational flyers about this workshop have been sent out to the surrounding residents and businesses. Updated information is also available on the City's Web site.

Graffiti-Tracker Program/Cross-Jurisdictional Anti-Graffiti Efforts

The City began using the Graffiti Tracker database system in late 2008 as part of increased anti-graffiti efforts by OPD, Code Enforcement, and Public Works staff. One main benefit of the program is that that the photo documentation of the graffiti can be referenced between jurisdictions for purposes of graffiti vandal prosecution. As reported in the local news, several graffiti taggers were recently been arrested in Vista. With the Graffiti Tracker system, similar incidents by these taggers in Oceanside may be added to a case involving vandalism charges and property damage restitution.
