HUD Performance Report

The Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) detailing use of Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnership and other federal, state and local program funds for housing and community development in the City is now available for public review. The report covers the period July 2008 through June of 2009. Copies are available at the Oceanside Public Library, City Clerk's office, Neighborhood Services Department office and on the City website. Written comments may be submitted no later than September 23. The CAPER will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on September 28, 2009.

CDBG funded social services policy recommendation

In response to the current budget challenges facing the City, the Neighborhood Services Department will bring a proposed policy change to the City Council in October regarding use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for public services. CDBG regulations allow use of up to fifteen percent of CDBG funds for social services ,including programs for youth and seniors, and support for agencies providing essential services to at-risk populations. The Department will propose to limit the fifteen percent public services allocations for support of programs in City facilities, including parks and recreation centers, community resource centers and senior centers. A second proposed change will be to use available funds from the Mortgage Revenue Bond Fund to support programs providing emergency housing. The Department will notify all current subrecipients of the proposed change in advance of the Council meeting.
