# COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

# September 24, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, September 28, 2009:

Mission Summit Communications Cell Site – Revocation of Conditional Use Permit for cell site at the Oceanside Women's Club located at 1606 Missouri Street for failure to comply with conditions of approval in the established time frames. *Staff is recommending revocation of the permit.* 

California Career School – To permit the operation of a temporary trucking school for a maximum five-years for vocational and occupational training located on the northeast corner of Rancho Del Oro Drive and Ocean Ranch Boulevard. *Staff is recommending approval.* 

South Pacific Street Property-Lot 18 – To permit the demolition of an existing multi-unit residential complex to enable the construction of an attached two-unit duplex consisting of 2,100 square feet for unit one and 3,364 square feet for unit two, with a shared eight-car tandem garage located at 833 South Pacific Street. *This item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-noticed and re-scheduled for a future hearing date.* 

## Teen Camping Trip

A group of teens from Crown Heights, Eastside and San Luis Rey will be participating in a 3 day team building camping trip October 2, 3, and 4. Campers will spend the weekend at the Magdalena YMCA lagoon in Carlsbad where they will enjoy fishing, canoeing, outdoor cooking and sleeping under the stars. There will be leadership and team building exercises incorporated into the recreational activities that are designed to encourage tolerance, respect and fair play.

## For Kids Sake (After School Program) "Service In Action"

As part of Joe Balderrama Recreation Center afterschool program curriculum, kids participate in weekly ongoing service projects. The 9-11 year olds walk the neighborhood every Monday afternoon to do a trash pick up, and also read aloud to the kids at the on-site daycare during the week. The 6-8 year olds conduct a weekly park ranger patrol, looking for trash, graffiti and safety items.

## Community Support by Parks & Recreation

Parks & Recreation has developed a (3) year continuing partnership with SNAP - a nonprofit spay/neuter mobile clinic. The clinic holds low cost / no cost neutering, vaccination and licensing clinics at Balderrama bi-monthly. SNAP has teamed up with North County Humane Society to identify and address pet overpopulation and licensing issues within the Eastside neighborhood. They actually contact pet owners and seek to educate in a positive, non-threatening way. There has been a significant decrease in pit-bull breeding and stray or abandoned dogs in the past year; largely due to sustained efforts from city and SNAP employees and volunteers. SNAP also provides year round humane education classes to JBRC program children and produces English and Spanish educational literature for distribution to neighbors.

#### Teen Program Back in Action

Teen nights are on again! School is back in session and Joe Balderrama Recreation Center has extended teen hours to accommodate recreational and educational needs for Eastside teens. Extended evening hours offer a chance for teens to come to recreate, get homework help and grab a healthy snack. The evening hours are designed to provide a safe haven for teens during critical hours of 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday. We will also be conducting a monthly Friday night teen trip to local attractions and exhibits. This past summer JBRC was a primary worksite for SER Hire-A-Youth summer job program. Five area teens completed 120 hours of job training during a two month period at JBRC. Teens learned valuable work related skills and had weekly one on one educational sessions with City staff for assessment and goal setting.
