

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

October 1, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 28, 2009:

Mission Summit Communications Cell Site – Revocation of Conditional Use Permit for cell site at the Oceanside Women’s Club located at 1606 Missouri Street for failure to comply with conditions of approval in the established time frames. ***This item has been continued to the November 2, 2009 Planning Commission meeting.***

California Career School – To permit the operation of a temporary trucking school for a maximum five-years for vocational and occupational training located on the northeast corner of Rancho Del Oro Drive and Ocean Ranch Boulevard. ***The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on October 8, 2009.***

South Pacific Street Property-Lot 18 – To permit the demolition of an existing multi-unit residential complex to enable the construction of an attached two-unit duplex consisting of 2,100 square feet for unit one and 3,364 square feet for unit two, with a shared eight-car tandem garage located at 833 South Pacific Street. ***This item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-noticed and re-scheduled for a future hearing date.***

Oceanside Parks & Recreation Division is partnering with Camp Pendleton for several Youth Flag Football games this season. Games will be played at Luiseño Park on Saturday mornings. This type of inter-league scheduling allows Oceanside youth and parents to interact with the youth and parents from Camp Pendleton and shows support and appreciation for our military families. Vista Community Clinic Awarded OJJDP Youth Mentoring Grant:

Vista Community Clinic has been awarded a Youth Mentoring Grant through the Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) to establish a mentoring program targeting youth at risk of gang activity, delinquency, and

youth violence. The grant is for a total of \$500,000 to be used over 3 years from FY 09-10 thru FY 11-12. The program will be provided at three schools in Oceanside (El Camino High School, Cesar Chavez Middle School, and Libby Lake Elementary School) and three schools in Vista (Vista High School, Washington Middle School, and Olive Elementary).

The curriculum will be based on evidence-based best practices for providing quality youth mentoring in schools and communities. Twenty adults will be recruited from existing local mentoring programs, colleges, and partnering agencies. Each adult will be assigned three junior mentors from the high schools (60 junior mentors) Each junior mentor will be assigned a mentee from an elementary or middle school that feeds into these high schools (total of 60 mentees) Mentoring programming will include youth development training to build community protective factors against gang involvement, structured activities for academic enrichment, and visits to local colleges and businesses for college and career development.

The program aims to:

- 1) decrease the number of local high school-age youth who become involved with gangs in the Oceanside and Vista Unified School Districts;
- 2) increase parental involvement in the lives of at-risk youth; and
- 3) monitor progress and assess program to improve the performance/outcomes for participating youth. Fulfillment of program objectives, including completion of program components and development of protective factors will be reviewed quarterly by staff, partners and community stakeholders.

Partners in Oceanside include: San Diego County Office of Education (SDCOE - PASS program), North County Lifeline, Oceanside Unified School District, and the City of Oceanside Neighborhood Services Department. Vista Community Clinic have been a long-term collaborative partner with the city in providing quality health care and after school prevention programs for our residents. This program will support ongoing efforts to reduce gang activity and promote positive youth development in Oceanside.
