COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

October 22, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, October 26, 2009:

<u>Seaside RH District Rowhome Prohibition</u> – To amend Article 1050(HH) of the Zoning Ordinance to prohibit the creation of 2,500 square foot lots for the development of single-family detached homes with the RH District of the Seaside Neighborhood, as bounded by Horne Street, Weitzel Street, Missouri Street, Michigan Street and Freeman Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Dillon Residence</u> – To permit the expansion of a master bedroom of an existing singlefamily residence located at 1011 South Pacific Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Avocado Road Parcel Map</u> – For a three-lot subdivision, which exceeds the base density and has panhandle access, on a 1.0-acre site located at 1814 Avocado Road. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>South Pacific Street Property-Lot 18</u> – To permit the demolition of an existing multi-unit residential complex to enable the construction of an attached two-unit duplex consisting of 2,100 square feet for unit one and 3,364 square feet for unit two, with a shared eight-car tandem garage located at 833 South Pacific Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Verizon Wireless @ Prince of Peace Abbey</u> – For the continued operation of an existing 80-foot tall stand-alone communication facility consisting of whip, panel, and microwave dish antennas and miner upgrades located at 695 Benet Hill Road. *Staff is recommending approval.*
