## COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

## November 5, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, November 2, 2009:

<u>Mission Summit Communications Cell Site</u> – Revocation of Conditional Use Permit for cell site at the Oceanside Women's Club located at 1606 Missouri Street for failure to comply with conditions of approval in the established time frames. *The Commission voted to take no action on the revocation for this project by a 5-1-1 vote.* 

<u>Mudge Residence</u> – To permit the demolition of an existing single-family home to construct a new two-story single-family residence located at 1721 South Pacific Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on November 12, 2009.* 

#### Rancho Del Oro Road and Cameo Drive Community Meeting

A traffic signal has been installed (but not yet activated) at the intersection of Rancho del Oro Drive and Cameo Drive. The Development Services Department is hosting a meeting on Thursday, November 12, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. at the El Corazon Senior Center to receive community input concerning the activation of the traffic signal. This item will be brought to City Council on December 16, 2009. As with other meetings of similar nature and in consideration of the Brown Act, the City Attorney's office advises that Councilmembers may attend this meeting; however activities should be limited to observation and not participation.

#### Meeting of Morro Hills to discuss sub-division requirements

The Morro Hills Growers Association has distributed a notice to Morro Hills property owners inviting them to attend a community meeting scheduled to be held on Thursday November 12, 2009, from 6:00 to 7:30 pm at Chavez Middle School (202 Oleander Dr.). According to the notice, the purpose of the meeting is two fold: a) to share with Morro Hills property owners Morro Hills Growers Association's planned actions for the next 12 months; and b) to outline what each one of the property owners will have to do – and pay for separately - if they wished to subdivide their property in the future. At the end of the meeting, Morro Hills Growers Association intends to invite property owners to join them in their anticipated planning efforts.

Development Services department staff will be in attendance as observers. As with other meetings of similar nature and in consideration of the Brown Act, the City Attorney's office advises that Councilmembers may attend this meeting, however activities should be limited to observation and not participation.

### Melrose Drive Extension Project

The City submitted the current Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) and all supporting technical studies to County parks and County planning staff members on October 1, 2009. At that time, the County indicated that they would return their

comments by November 11, 2009. County staff are still reviewing the documents, but it appears that their review may needs more time. However, City staffs are currently working with County staffs to complete their review as soon as possible with the goal of revising the DEIR for public review by end of November. After 60 days of public review, the staff and its consultants will address the comments and produce the Final EIR.

### Ronny Cox concert Nov. 6 cancelled

The Library's World Music concert scheduled for Friday November 6 has been cancelled due to the illness of the performer, Ronny Cox. Ticket holders may contact Library Administration at 760-435-5560 to receive a refund. Ronny Cox will be rescheduled to perform at a later date in the spring.
