COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

November 19, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, November 16, 2009:

Pacific Coast Business Park Revision – For modifications to a previously approved project to allow additional commercial and medical office use and reduce the industrial park use from 1,100,000 square feet to 901,500 square feet located within the boundaries east of Ocean Ranch Boulevard, north of Avenida De La Plata, west of College Boulevard, and south of Old Grove Road. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on November 30, 2009.*

<u>Walgreens</u> – For the demolition of an existing gas station and construction of a 13,654 square foot retail building offering pharmacy services, with a drive-through window located at 4181 Oceanside Boulevard. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on November 30, 2009.*

Winter Shelter to Open

North County regional winter emergency shelters will open December 1, 2009, at locations in Oceanside, Carlsbad, Vista and Escondido; the shelters will remain open until March 31, 2010. Bread of Life Rescue Mission in Oceanside (760-722-0800) has facilities for 25 men and 25 women, and provides an evening meal for guests. Breakfast and showers are available at Brother Benno's. Operation HOPE in Vista (760-724-0015) has facilities for families and single women. Information on all programs for homeless individuals and families is available at the interfaith Community Services Coastal office at 2195 Oceanside Boulevard.

Parks and Recreation Clinics

Oceanside Parks & Recreation will be hosting FREE Youth Basketball Skills Clinics for the 300 registered participants for winter youth basketball and teen basketball leagues. This event will be held on Saturday, November 21 at the Melba Bishop Gym.

Youth Rugby

Community volunteers including Save our Streets and The Hurricane Rugby League are working with Parks & Recreation staff to host a Free Rugby clinic this Saturday, November 21, at Joe Balderrama Park from 11:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. This collaborative effort brings free recreational opportunities to Eastside youth ages 8 to 18 and encourages outdoor play, fitness and team work. Eastside children are forming a Balderrama team, and will be participating in a structured Rugby league beginning January 2010.

Parks & Recreation staff, along with a core group of coaches and adult mentors, have been conducting monthly clinics to introduce the youth to the sport. Clinic components

include conditioning exercises, fun games and one on one coaching and mentoring. The Save our Streets group will also be on hand this Saturday to cheer on the kids and bring cup stacking fun for our youth.
