Administrative Approval

Downs Residence – For the construction of two single-family homes on two separate parcels located at the northeast corner of Downs Street and Dunstan Street and within the Fire Mountain Neighborhood. *Administrative approval on November 30, 2009 and the appeal period ends on December 10, 2009.*

Senior Shuttle Service in High Demand

The senior shuttle service provided contractually by American Logistics Company has seen a major increase in demand for service. Due to this sudden volume, staff limited the daily one-way trips to nine trips per day, in order to extend service through June 30, 2010. Longer term solutions may include increasing the age requirement from 65 to 75 years of age, limiting rides to only medical appointments, increasing the cost to the senior passenger which is currently \$5 per ride, or continuing to limit daily trips available. Additional funding sources are continuously being sought. Staff will be assessing the options and will make a recommendation next month.

Senior Nutrition Program

The Senior Nutrition Program will hold their Christmas Luncheon on December 23rd at the Oceanside Senior Center at 11:30 am. The cost is \$2.75 for those over 60 years of age, \$5 for those under 60. No reservations are necessary.

Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP)

The City received funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to establish the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program. The program assists low-income Oceanside families to attain housing stability by providing case management services and temporary financial assistance. HPRP serves persons who are homeless or would be homeless without this assistance and can remain stably housed after the program ends. The funds cannot be used for mortgage assistance and are not intended to serve persons who need long-term and/or intensive supports. Household income cannot exceed fifty percent of the county median income per household size; for a family of four, the maximum annual income is \$41,300. Staff is collaborating with the Homeless Services liaisons at Oceanside and Vista Unified School Districts to ensure that families receive services available through the schools. For
