COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

December 17, 2009

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, December 14, 2009:

<u>Beach Break Plaza</u> – For the construction of two-unit 4,023 square foot commercial building for a restaurant and a retail suite on a 0.413 acre site located at 1802 South Coast Highway. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on December 24, 2009.*

Administrative Approval

Verizon Wireless – For the continued operation of a previously approved and fully operational telecommunications facility with 3 arrays of 4 panel antennas and 1 two-foot diameter microwave antenna behind the parapet wall of the associated commercial building with an at grade equipment enclosure located at 3513 Cannon Road within the Ocean Hills Neighborhood. *Administrative approval on December 14, 2009, and the appeal period ends on December 24, 2009.*

Volunteers Thanked

Volunteers in the City's senior services programs were treated to a reception this past Tuesday with songs of the season and a wide array of snacks prepared by the Oceanside Senior Citizens Association. Each of the volunteers also received a small rosemary bush for their homes; these were donated to the City by The Pinery in Escondido. The plants can serve as miniature Christmas trees and then be planted in the spring. The Director of Neighborhood Services will send a letter of thanks to the Pinery for their donation.

Award of Funding for Homebuyer Program

At its December 16, 2009, meeting the California Debt Limit Allocation Committee (CDLAC) awarded the City of Oceanside \$3 million in Mortgage Credit Certificates to use to help Oceanside first-time homebuyers receive a 20% credit on their annual tax returns. This is in addition to the \$1.2 million the City received in its September 2009 application.

This additional funding was made possible by the collaboration and timely response of several departments and key staff working together to fast-track an application to CDLAC in time for the December meeting. Credit goes to Margery Pierce and Barbara Lindsey of Neighborhood Services as the lead applicants pushing through the paperwork; Patti Allison of City Manager's office to keep track of the enabling application resolution; Barbara Riegel Wayne and her staff for an immediate resolution signing and certifying a copy of the resolution in time to FedEx a complete application to CDLAC by the meeting deadline.
