

## **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

**February 7, 2008**

### **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, February 11, 2008:

Sprint-Nextel Communications -- For the construction and operation of a stand-alone communication facility consisting of 9-panel antennas and a 200-square-foot equipment enclosure located at 4700 Mesa Drive. Staff recommends approval.

Pacific View Medical Office -- To construct a 39,835-square-foot medical office building and to allow surgery as part of a hospital land use on property located at 3300 Waring Road. Staff recommends approval.

Sandifer Variance -- To allow the encroachment into the front yard requirement for the construction of a swimming pool located at 2329 Snead Drive. Staff recommends approval.

Newman Residence -- To permit a residential structure to exceed the maximum height requirement located at 517 South Tremont Street. This item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-scheduled and re-noticed for a future public hearing.
