### **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, February 25, 2008:

Seagate Corporate Center -- To subdivide an existing lot and create 12 industrial condominiums on an existing 1.22-acre parcel located at 3546 Seagate Way. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; the call for review/appeal period ends on March 6, 2008.

Singh Farms Amendment -- To amend an existing development plan to allow the construction of a building on an existing concrete pad located at 5780 Mission Avenue. The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution; the call for review/appeal period ends on March 6, 2008.

Lozano Residence -- To allow a one-car garage to remain as it is after constructing a 1,575.5-square foot addition to an existing single-family residence located at 516 Barnwell Street. The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution; the call for review/appeal period ends on March 6, 2008.
