

## **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

**March 13, 2008**

### **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, March 10, 2008:

Cricket at Amazon Bikes -- To construct and operate three antennas attached to three remodeled light poles located at 1227 Vista Way. The Commission approved the project by a 5-2 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on March 20, 2008.

LDS Church -- For construction of pavilion building in accessory to the church located at 2080 California Street. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on March 20, 2008.

Palm Tree Plaza Parcel Map -- To permit a lot parcel map within the Palm Tree Plaza Shopping Center located at the southwest corner of Lake Boulevard and Cannon Road. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on March 20, 2008.

### **Dredging Operation**

The Department of Harbor and Beaches held a preconstruction meeting with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and their dredging subcontractor, Manson Construction Co. Traditionally the dredging operation has started after our City's Ironman Event, which will be held March 29. However, due to the need to insure all the dredging pipes are off the beach prior to the Soccer Championships, May 2 -4; the City has requested that they begin dredging as soon as possible. Pipes and equipment may begin to arrive within the next few weeks in preparation of the actual dredging which has a target date of starting April 1 through April 12, and having all pipes off the beach by April 22.

**Manufactured Home Fair Practices Commission Meeting, April 3, 2008**

The Manufactured Home Fair Practices Commission will meet on Thursday, April 3, to consider applications for the Annual Permissive Adjustment from 17 mobilehome parks. A park owner is entitled to increase space rents annually effective July 1 for regulated mobilehome spaces, provided that the park is in compliance with the City’s Rent Control Ordinance, including registering the park and passing a health and safety inspection conducted by the Building Department. The permissive adjustment increase is 1.73 percent.
