Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, April 21, 2008:

Sandy Beach Residence -- For the demolition of one residential structure which is part of the El Sereno Cottages and located within the 800 block of South Pacific Street. ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 1, 2008.***

Sunset View Residence -- For the demolition of three residential units that are part of the El Sereno Cottages and located within the 800 block of South Pacific Street. ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 1, 2008.***

South Pacific Street Residence -- To allow for the demolition of a 2,196 square foot single family residence and construct a new 6,859 square foot single family residence with a three-car garage located at 1611 South Pacific Street. ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 1, 2008.***
