# **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, May 5, 2008:

Guajome Regional Park Communication Facility Master Plan -- For the construction of a stand-alone communication facility, two co-user communication facilities, and for construction above the height limit located at 3002 Guajome Lake Road. The proposal is to construct 3 monopoles disguised as trees with heights between 59 ft. and 63 ft. and to construct a 2,006-square foot equipment shelter for ancillary communication equipment. Up to six communication services may operate at this site. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 15, 2008.* 

Powers Residence -- For the construction of a 5,372-square foot single-family home and tandem off-street parking located in the 800 block of South Pacific Street. *This item has been continued to the May 19, 2008 Planning Commission meeting.* 

Laguna Pacifica -- For the subdivision of an approximately 0.55-acre site into two lots and the development of a new single-family detached dwelling (for a total of two) located at 2020 Stewart Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-2 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 15, 2008.* 

Vespa of Oceanside -- To allow motorized scooter and motorcycles sales, repair and rentals at 1725 South Coast Highway. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 15, 2008.* 

Coastline Baptist Church -- To incorporate 2,800 square feet of existing commercial space to the existing church located at 547 Vista Bella. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 15, 2008.* 

Ocean's 11 Card Club -- To permit the addition of five card tables to an existing casino and card room facility at Ocean's 11 Casino located at 121 Brooks Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 15, 2008.*

# Coast Highway Corridor Planning Update

On April 16th the City Council awarded a professional services contract to the urban design/architectural firm of Torti Gallas and Partners, Inc., of Los Angeles in the amount of \$260,000 to prepare a vision and strategic plan for Coast Highway. The project was initiated on May 1st with a City staff and consultant kick-off meeting. Upcoming efforts will primarily focus on project area field assessment and land use, market, mobility and parking data research and analysis. This information will be made available to the public and will serve to inform participants during two 1-week long design charrettes scheduled to be held July 28-August1 (North Coast Hwy) and August 25-29 (Mid and South Coast Hwy) at the Civic Center/Community Rooms. A developer's forum for the Coast Hwy Vision and Strategic Plan is tentatively planned for September. Following that the plan will be further refined and presented to City Committees and Commissions. Conclusion of this master planning process is anticipated by spring of 2009 with a presentation to the City Council.
