

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

May 23, 2008

Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, May 19, 2008:

Powers Residence -- For the construction of a 5,372-square foot single-family home and tandem off-street parking located in the 800 block of South Pacific Street. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; the call for review/appeal period ends on May 29, 2008.

Caulfield Residence Addition -- To allow for the addition of 839 square feet of living space to an existing single-family residence located at 2023 South Pacific Street. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; the call for review/appeal period ends on May 29, 2008.

Newman Residence -- To permit a residential structure to exceed the maximum height requirement located at 517 South Tremont Street. The Commission denied the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution; the call for review/appeal period ends on May 29, 2008.

El Camino Executive Center -- For the development of a 32,616-square foot office building located east of El Camino Real and south of Skyline Drive. This item was removed from the agenda and will be re-scheduled and re-noticed for the June 9, 2008, Planning Commission meeting.

Pothole Repair Program

The Public Works Department has been devoting considerable effort to repairing as many potholes as possible this fiscal year. Focus has been primarily on the arterial streets which are the most heavily traveled. They will repair about 16,000 square feet of potholes; to date about half of the work has been completed.

Citywide Recreation Classes
