Development Productivity and User Fee Study

Matrix Consulting Group, the firm hired to conduct the organizational study of the Development Services Department and Fire Prevention Bureau, has started its work. First stages of the study involve individual interviews with departmental personnel involved in the development process. Interviews will also be scheduled with members of the City Council, City Attorney's staff, and those involved in the development community. Focus groups will be established in order to gain feedback from those with whom the department conducts business. It is anticipated that completion of the study will take approximately five months. The second phase, an analysis of the department's fee structure, will follow the initial organizational analysis.

Filipino Cultural Celebration on June 7

The 7th annual Filipino Cultural Celebration will be held on Saturday, June 7, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the Library and Civic Center Plaza. The program includes a salute to local heroes, traditional costume show, a performance of regional dances of the Philippines, crafts and stories for children, and a talent showcase hosted by popular radio personality "Hula". The event is sponsored by the Fil-Am Cultural Association of North County and the Friends of the Oceanside Public Library.

Crown Heights Community Festival

On June 7, 2008, North County Lifeline and the City of Oceanside will host a community festival in the Crown Heights neighborhood. The event draws hundreds of local residents and will take place at the Crown Heights Community Resource Center at 1210 Division Street from 11:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m. The annual festival provides outreach and resources to the individuals and families who live in neighborhood. The event is funded by Coca-Cola for Youth by Youth grant. Approximately 25 local agencies and organizations will attend to provide information, including: Oceanside Fire Department, North County Health Services, McAlister Institute, Community Housing Works, Rady Children's Hospital First 5, C3 Mira Costa College, Cal State San Marcos, Boys & Girls Club of Oceanside and the Fair Housing Council of San Diego. Fun activities include a rock-climbing wall, a giant inflatable slide and obstacle course. In addition, the crowd will be entertained by Ballet Folklorico Tapatio and Calpulli Omeyocan Aztec dancers.
