# **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, June 9, 2008:

<u>Ben's Recycling</u> -- To relocate an existing commercial recycling facility located at 2229 San Luis Rey Drive to 395 Via Del Monte. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on June 19, 2008.

<u>Smith/Spitz Property</u> -- For the construction of two residential structures located at 1925 South Myers Street. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on June 19, 2008.

<u>El Camino Executive Center</u> -- For the development of a 32,616-square foot office building located east of El Camino Real and south of Skyline Drive. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on June 19, 2008.

Staff from ERA will attend the meeting as observers.

## "Solutions for Seniors on the Go"

The TransNet Senior Mini Grant evaluation committee has recommended the City of Oceanside senior transportation program for funding over the next three years, Fiscal Years 2009-2011. The recommendation of \$638,915 is scheduled for the Independent Taxpayer's Oversight Committee (ITOC) for next week. After review by the ITOC, recommendations will go to the Transportation Committee on July 25, 2008, for approval. The TransNet Senior Mini Grant program requires a 20% match from other funding sources. If approved, the City's senior taxi scrip, shuttle services, and volunteer driver service would be funded through Fiscal Year 2011.
