COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

June 26, 2008

Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, June 23, 2008:

<u>Enright Parcel Map II</u> -- To subdivide and create a two-unit residential condominium located at 1213 South Pacific Street. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on July 3, 2008.

<u>Jack in the Box</u> -- To allow the development of a 2,692-square foot drive-thru restaurant on a 0.96-acre parcel located at the northeast corner of Mission Avenue and Canyon Drive. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on July 3, 2008.

Hernandez Residence -- For the demolition of an existing sunroom and construction of a 315-square foot room addition on the single-family residence located at 1618 South Pacific Street. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on July 3, 2008.

Oracle Software Upgrades

The project plan is completed. Funding for Phase II will be presented to the City Council for their review and approval in early August. IT is responsible for getting the hardware and 8.12 web-platform in place and they anticipate having it ready sometime during August. Once the hardware is in place, the Finance project team will begin testing the system. This will allow staff time to get accustomed to the new "look" of Oracle and workout customized processing issues prior to going live, tentatively scheduled for early February 2009.

COGNOS Report Writing

The COGNOS training was postponed by IT in April. COGNOS is expected to replace Crystal, the current report writing software. IT will retain Crystal until January 2009; however, no new reports will be able to be created in Crystal. COGNOS training will resume in January 2009 prior to the Oracle "go-live" date.

Summer Lunch Program

There has been a tremendous response to the free summer lunch program being sponsored by Oceanside Unified School District. Joe Balderrama and Melba Bishop Recreation Centers, San Luis Rey and Crown Heights Community Resource Centers, and the Boys and Girls Club of Oceanside (Townsite and Libby Lake Branches) are all participating in the program. Attendance at these sites has built steadily to over 550 free lunches daily. All children 18 years and under are eligible.

OUSD is also operating a mobile lunch van this year, serving lunches at Libby Lake Park, where attendance started at 118 and was reported recently to be 200 daily. Free lunches are also served at Oceanside High School and Mission Elementary. Campfire USA in Crown Heights will begin serving lunches on June 30. CAVALIER MOBILE ESTATES REQUEST FOR A RENT INCREASE

On June 23, 2008, Cavalier Mobile Estates located at 1225 Oceanside Boulevard, submitted an application to increase rents by \$1.35 monthly to cover increased insurance costs related to the Sprinter crossing at the park entrance. All 346 park spaces are subject to the City's rent control ordinance and would be affected by the proposed increase. City staff will be working with park management to obtain additional information needed to process the application. Staff has tentatively scheduled a meeting of the Manufactured Home Fair Practices Commission on August 7, 2008, to consider the rent increase application.
