# **GRAND OPENING FOR VETERAN TRANSITIONAL HOUSING IN OCEANSIDE**

Interfaith Community Services will host a grand opening of a new supportive housing program in Oceanside for homeless and recently separated veterans on Wednesday, July 16 from 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The program, located at 1234 Division Street, will provide housing for 72 male and female veterans. Vocational training, counseling and other supportive services designed to help the veterans obtain secure income and permanent housing for independent, self-sufficient civilian life will be provided off-site. The Veterans Administration has provided funding for acquisition of the building and for the program; services will be provided off-site at the Interfaith Coastal Service Center at 2195 Oceanside Boulevard.
