Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, July 14, 2008:

<u>Howe Variance and Barn</u> -- To locate a gate within the required front yard and to construct a barn on an 8.99-acre lot located at 686 Sleeping Indian Road. The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on July 24, 2008.

Coast Highway Visioning Noticing

During the week of July 14, 2008, a total of 8,800 Pre-charrette newsletters will be distributed via mail to residents, property owners and business owners located within the Coast Highway Vision and Strategic Plan area. The newsletters will serve as an open invitation to members of the public encouraging their participation in the visioning and planning process for Coast Highway. The public is invited to participate in two 1-week long design charrettes which will take place July 28 through August 1 (North Coast Highway charrette) and August 25 - 29 (Mid & South Coast Highway charrette) at the Community Rooms/Civic Center. Additional Citywide public notification of the charrettes has been provided in water bill mailings and will also be provided through advertisement in the local newspaper (North County Times) on the July 17, 18, 19 and 20 and advertisements will appear again in the newspaper in mid-August prior to that charrette. The Community News section of the North County Times has also listed the upcoming charettes.

Senior Citizen Services
