Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, July 28, 2008:

Sing Residence -- To allow for a reduced side yard setback for a recreational vehicle garage addition to a single-family residence located at 796 Muirwood Drive. Staff recommends denial.

Essex Rancho Del Oro Time Extension -- To subdivide and create a 17-unit industrial condominium within two buildings located at 4096 Calle Platino. Staff recommends approval.

Rentals & Home Owners Rebate Program
