### **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

### July 31, 2008

#### Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, July 28, 2008:

<u>Sing Residence</u> -- To allow for a reduced side-yard setback for a recreational vehicle garage addition to a single-family residence located at 796 Muirwood Drive. The Commission denied the project without prejudice by a 5-1 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on August 7, 2008.

<u>Essex Rancho Del Oro Time Extension</u> -- To subdivide and create a 17-unit industrial condominium within two buildings located at 4096 Calle Platino. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on August 7, 2008.

#### Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008

Congress has passed and the President has promised to sign the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008 (HR3221) which, among other provisions, appropriates \$3.9 billion for use by the States and local jurisdictions for the redevelopment of abandoned and foreclosed upon homes and residential properties. The money will be made available through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The bill requires HUD to develop a funding formula within sixty days for allocation of the funds; this new formula is to be based on the number and percentage in each State or local jurisdictions of home foreclosures, the number and percentage of homes in default or delinquency. The States and local jurisdictions will have eighteen months following receipt of such funds to purchase and redevelop abandoned and foreclosed homes and residential properties. There is no requirement for matching funds. The Neighborhood Services Department – Housing and Code Enforcement Division will provide additional information as HUD prepares program regulations and guidelines.

#### Senior Citizen Services

Legal services are provided every third Wednesday and fourth Tuesday at the Senior Center located on 455 Country Club Lane.

#### **Rentals & Home Owners Rebate Program**

This program started July 8, and will continue until Oct 10. A claimant must be a U.S. citizen or a designated alien; 62 years or older, blind, or disabled; and have a total household income of \$44,096 or less to receive rebate.
