Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 8, 2008:

New Song Community Church -- For the continued use of a church with interior tenant improvements located at 3985 Mission Avenue. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on September 18, 2008.

Old Mission San Luis Rey De Francia -- To amend the Planned Development (PD) Plan established for the 54.5-acre Mission San Luis Rey de Francia parcel, and developed in order to provide a long range build out strategy for establishing appropriate land uses, needed in infrastructure, and design guidelines for the property located at 4050 Mission Avenue. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on September 18, 2008.

<u>Mesa Ridge</u> -- For the development of 68 townhome units on a 23.8 acre site located at the northeastern corner of Mesa Drive and Foussat Road. The Commission approved the project and the amendment by a 5-2 vote and adopted the resolutions. The amendment and project are anticipated to go to City Council on November 12, 2008.

OPD ANNOUNCES NEW INVESTIGATIVE UNIT

On August 11, 2008, the Investigations Division moved into their new offices to form the Robbery-Homicide Unit. The unit was started to focus attention on violent crimes. The unit is comprised of 1 Sergeant, 6 Detectives and 1 Field Evidence Technician. The Investigations Unit also added a Postal Inspector, a State Parole Agent, and an agent from Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF).

FRESH NEW LOOK FOR OPD WEB SITE

September 10, 2008, OPD launched the new version of the OPD Web site to provide greater information and access to the department. Several updated features to combat graffiti, gangs, and drug abuse are on the site. The site also features a link to the Oceanside Alerts system. The more than 300 OPD employees are working harder to interact with the community and continuing to build positive relationships.
