Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, September 22, 2008:

<u>Walk Residence</u> -- To demolish an existing single-family residence and construct a 6,047 square foot single-family residence and a four-car tandem parking garage located at 825 South Pacific Street. Staff recommends approval.

<u>Lil Jackson</u> -- To create two lots and construct an 80-unit residential structure located in the 3800 block of Lake Boulevard. Staff recommends approval.

<u>Pacific Coast Medical Center Parcels 27, 28 and 29</u> -- To develop 11 medical office buildings on 3 parcels of the Pacific Coast Business Park. The proposed combined area for the medical center is approximately 7.88-acres in size and would allow for 10 single-story and one two-story medical office building totaling 80,284 square feet in size and further subdivided into 45 airspace condominium units located west of Trestles Street, between Rocky Point Drive and Old Grove Road. Staff recommends approval.

El Corazon Specific Plan and Draft EIR

The El Corazon Specific Plan and Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) will be available for public review and comment from Thursday, September 18, 2008, through Thursday, November 6, 2008. The DEIR and the Specific Plan can be viewed on the City's Web site (El Corazon Link), at the Planning Division, or at the City's Main and Mission Branch Libraries starting September 18.

Employer Support for the Guard and Reserve Above and Beyond Award

Employer Support for the Guard and Reserve (ESGR) is a Department of Defense organization, which provides information and resources to employers regarding the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Acts.

Each year ESGR selects one large private company, one small private company and one public sector agency for their service, support and commitment to military reserve and guard employees.

Employers can only be nominated by their employees. This year, the City of Oceanside was again nominated for this coveted award and we were fortunate to be the recipient for Southern California "Above and Beyond Award".

Melrose Drive Extension

First draft of the EIR should be ready for staff review in mid-December 2008. Currently, City staff is working with County's Park and Recreation to work out the details of park land exchange and County's request for an equestrian undercross at North Santa Fe and Melrose Drive. SANDAG has completed the Series 11 traffic model; City staff and their consultant have reviewed the model. Scoping meetings were held on January 24, and March 13, 2008.
