#### Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 22, 2008:

<u>Walk Residence</u> -- To demolish an existing single-family residence and construct a 6,047 square foot single-family residence and a four-car tandem parking garage located at 825 South Pacific Street. The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on October 2, 2008.

<u>Lil Jackson</u> -- To create two lots and construct an 80-unit residential structure located in the 3800 block of Lake Boulevard. This item was continued to the October 6, 2008, Planning Commission public hearing.

Pacific Coast Medical Center Parcels 27, 28 and 29 -- To develop eleven medical office buildings on three parcels of the Pacific Coast Business Park. The proposed combined area for the medical center is approximately 7.88-acres in size and would allow for 10 single-story and one two-story medical office building totaling 80,284 square feet in size and further subdivided into 45 airspace condominium units located west of Trestles Street, between Rocky Point Drive and Old Grove Road. The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on October 2, 2008.
