

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

October 2, 2008

Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, October 6, 2008:

Lil Jackson -- To create two lots and construct an 80-unit residential structure located in the 3800 block of Lake Boulevard. Staff recommends approval.

Sprint @ SDG&E Substation -- For the construction and operation of a stand-alone communication facility located at 801 El Camino Real. Staff recommends approval.

Windstar Ocean Ranch Lot 19 -- To allow for the construction of 12 industrial buildings on Lot 19 of the Ocean Ranch Corporate Center located east of Rancho Del Oro Road and north of Ocean Ranch Boulevard. The parcel map would place each building on a single lot, with the parking lot and open space as one common lot. The proposed buildings would have a total square footage of 220,600 sq. ft. Staff recommends approval.

Oceanside Pavilion -- For the development of a 950,000 square foot shopping center on a 92-acre site located at the northeast corner of Foussat Road and State Route 76. Staff recommends approval.

El Corazon Planning

The El Corazon Oversight Committee (ECOC) will be hosting a public meeting on October 27, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council chambers regarding the draft Specific Plan and the Draft Environmental Impact Report.

Senior Citizens Day Expo

Solutions for Seniors on the Go

Solutions for Seniors on the Go is a senior transportation program comprised of three services offered by the City; taxi scrip, senior shuttle, and volunteer driver service. The program received approval of a TransNet senior mini-grant by the SANDAG Board of Directors on Friday, September 26, for \$638,915 over the next three years. The City will be required to match this grant by 20 percent. The match will consist of volunteer hours, personnel costs, and an annual taxi scrip allocation generated from the previous year's revenue. Additionally, the shuttle service will continue on a month-to-month basis until all funds are expended by the Genentech Foundation grant. There is a

remaining balance of approximately \$43,000 to be spent over the next 5-6 months toward shuttle services.
