Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, November 3, 2008:

<u>Amazon Bikes Remodel</u> -- To construct a 1,800 square-foot addition to an existing commercial building located at 1227 Vista Way. Staff recommends approval.

<u>Hensel Parcel Map Subdivision</u> -- To allow the subdivision of an existing 1.02-acre parcel into two lots located at 1846 Avocado Road. Staff recommends approval.
