Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, November 3, 2008:

<u>Amazon Bikes Remodel</u> -- To construct a 1,800 square foot addition to an existing commercial building located at 1227 Vista Way. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on November 13, 2008.

<u>Hensel Parcel Map Subdivision</u> -- To allow the subdivision of an existing 1.02-acre parcel into two lots located at 1846 Avocado Road. This item has been continued to the next regularly scheduled Planning Commission meeting on November 17, 2008.

Public Works Traffic Maintenance

Since April 2008, the Public Works Traffic Maintenance crew has completed 7 of 12 zones in the City, or roughly 176 linear miles of striping. Striping of street lines includes centerlines, bike lane lines, edgelines, turn lane lines, etc. Public Works anticipates completing all 12 zones by April 2009. Then just like painting the Golden Gate Bridge the process will start all over again. The new striping will hopefully provide Oceanside citizens and visitors with a safer driving experience. Beginning in November and during the colder winter months, the crew will turn its attention to more sign and legend work.

Martin Luther King, Jr. Civic Award

Nomination forms for the 2009 City of Oceanside Martin Luther King, Jr. Civic Award are now available at City Hall, the Oceanside Public Library and Mission BranchLibrary, and at Community Resource Centers. The form is also available on the City Web site on the Community Relations Commission Web page. This annual award honors a resident of Oceanside who exemplifies the philosophy and ideals of the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and other leaders who have worked to improve community life, develop positive relationships in the community and enhance the lives of individuals. The award particularly emphasizes contributions and service to the people and City of Oceanside by a person outside of a work setting and over a long period of time. The 2009 recipient will be announced at the annual commemoration of Dr. King in January; this will be the twentieth year for the award. The deadline for nominations is December 31, 2008, call 435-3393 for more information.

Winter Shelters

The Alliance for Regional Solutions (ARS) will open four winter shelters on December 1, 2009, to serve homeless persons and families in North San Diego County. The Alliance is a collaborative effort of nonprofit social service and faith-based organizations in the region, with funding from all North County jurisdictions, United Way and San Diego

County Health and Human Services. Bread of Life Rescue Mission in Oceanside is one of the four shelters operative under the ARS umbrella and will remain open through March 31, 2009. Shelter managers recommend that persons seeking shelter first call 2-1-1 for the most up-to-date information on available shelter beds. Oceanside Police officers, Code Enforcement officers and Fire Department personnel will all have information for referrals.
