

## **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

**November 17, 2008**

### **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, November 17, 2008:

Kruger Property Variance – To permit a 54-foot tall ground mounted HAM radio antenna that exceeds the maximum allowable height requirement located at 142 Carey Road. Staff recommends denial.

Eaton Street Property Remodel – To construct a 340-square foot covered patio with a roof deck and the development of an 80-square foot addition to an existing single-family residence located at 311 Eaton Street. Staff recommends approval.

Hensel Parcel Map Subdivision -- To allow the subdivision of an existing 1.02-acre parcel into two lots located at 1846 Avocado Road. Staff recommends approval.

**Youth Cross-Country Meet:** The second annual Parks & Recreation Cross-Country Meet will be held on Saturday, November 22, 2008. The meet begins at 9:00 a.m. at the Melba Bishop Park. Pre-registration is required.

**Senior Shuttle Service:** The City was awarded \$23,300 from the New Freedom Grant Program by the SANDAG Board of Directors in September. A contract for the funds is currently being administered by staff and will be presented to City Council on December 17, 2008. The funds will be utilized to continue the senior shuttle program that was initiated by a Genentech Foundation Grant. The original program period ended on September 1, 2008 however the Genentech Foundation approved an extension until all funds are expended. Additionally, staff will be presenting senior transportation information to Ocean Hills HOA in early December.
